Prize: The Whitbread Trophy

Date: Sunday 24th July 2011

Time: Race Start 10.00 hrs. (bst)

Start Line: Exe Safe Water Mark – Committee Boat

Start Sequence:

Signal Sound Minutes before Start

11.55 hrs Warning 1 Blast (5Minutes)

11.56 hrs Preparatory 1 Blast (4Minutes)

11.59 hrs One-Minute 1 Blast (1Minutes)

12.00 hrs Starting 1 Blast (0 Minutes)

Class Flag: SFCC Burgee (Optional)

Course:

Start > Teignmouth outfall buoy (Pt) > Ore Stone (Stb) Round Ore stone (Stb) > Finish Line.

Take your time when abeam the Ore Stone (outward)

(This will be used if the race has to be abandoned due to lack of wind).

Any Alteration to this Course will be announced by the Race Officer prior to the 5 Minute Warning Signal on VHF Channel 77

Beware of the sunker rock to the south of the ore stone.

Finish Line:

A line drawn between the River Exe safe water mark and the number 2 Red Can with the safe water mark to stb. Take elapsed time when crossing line and note the boats immediately in front of and behind you.

Time Limit: 1900 hrs.

Declarations: Declarations must be handed to a race official in the Club Bar prior to 2000 hrs on Sunday evening.

Late declarations will be discarded.

Results: Results will be published on the Club Notice Board as soon as practical after the Race.
